COVID-19 update

Dear friends of Northwest Hennepin Family Service Collaborative (NWHFSC),

We are reaching out to share our near-term plan as our communities address the current COVID-19 health crisis. At NWHFSC, our work is to provide family advocate services, immunizations, preventive mental health, and resources for families and children impacted by poverty. We have a long history of working collaboratively and continue to be committed to being a part of northwest Hennepin area family successes.

We understand that needs for resources and support may increase during this time. In response, while the NWHFSC and partner offices are closed to staff and clients, we will be continuing to serve clients in each of our program areas, remotely.

Here are the ways that we are continuing to prioritize our clients and offer care:

- Our teams are developing outreach and service plans for their clients. We know that for the near-term we are planning to continue preventive mental health for middle school age students, family advocate services, and other essential services for existing appointments based on our capacity and mandates.
- Each active client of immunization, family advocate case management or preventive mental health will be receiving a check-in this week to help make a plan that meets their needs. We will **innovate ways to support**

our clients, including telmed check-in's with preventive mental health clients when feasible.

 To help provide a safety net and clarity for our clients, we are collaborating closely with our health systems, school district and nonprofit partners to best serve our communities during this time and support our direct service practitioners in meeting their system requirements

NWHFSC will continue to share updates to support access to our programs as our community response evolves. Based on the experiences of other communities across the nation, we expect that we will likely need to reduce these services in the coming weeks.

While we have the capacity and means to do much of our work remotely, we want to do all that we can to support the children and families that we serve. Working together. Supporting family success.
